4. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

a. Description of Request:

Add a data element to the PDA, PDA Quick Response and Allocation Statement data sets. These data sets need to support both single and multi-level (tiered) allocations.

b. Description of Recommendation:

c. Business Purpose:

There is not a data element that would clearly identify the role of the party submitting the PDA and the level of information contained within the Allocation Statement. A party may perform multiple roles at the same location and therefore multiple PDAs may need to be provided. The data element will need to be present on the PDA Quick Response so there can be a clear communication of PDAs accepted or containing errors when multiple PDAs have been submitted by a party. The data element is also needed on the Allocation Statement to clearly communicate the level of information contained in the data set.

d. Commentary/Rationale of Subcommittee(s)/Task Force(s):

IR: Implementation per BPS recommendation. Added sentence clarifying that the data element contains alpha-numeric data for consistent implementation with recommendations on Request Nos. R97055 and R97056.
