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**Applicable Regulatory Authority:** The state regulatory agency or other local governing body that provides oversight, policy guidance, and direction to any parties involved in the process of providing energy to Retail Customers through regulations and orders.

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#### 4. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

### a. Description of Request:

2010 Retail Annual Plan Item No. 11 – Review the definitions of all defined terms in Book 0 - Master List of Defined Terms, including other ratified terms not yet published, and revise the definitions of all defined terms not specifically related solely to the competitive marketplace to broaden their applicability to conform to NAESB's expanded scope.

### b. Description of Recommendation:

Several terms were identified and the definitions were revised. These are listed for inclusion in Book 0 and in the remaining Books as noted after each revised definition.

### c. Business Purpose:

Several current Model Business Practice development efforts need to use the terms included in this Recommendation. The definitions have been revised to broaden their applicability to permit use in the new Model Business Practices.

### d. Commentary/Rationale of Subcommittee(s)/Task Force(s):

The Joint REQ/RGQ Glossary Subcommittee discussed the terms and definitions, and voted the revised definitions out of subcommittee at a face-to-face meeting on August 16, 2010 and during a conference call on September 13, 2010. Minutes of both meetings are posted on the NAESB web site.

The Joint REQ/RGQ BPS subsequently accepted the revised definitions by using them in the development of new Model Business Practices.
