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NAESB AT A GLANCE: MONTHLY UPDATE

UPDATE ON PARALLEL FLOW VISUALIZATION: Mr. Skiba, co-chair of the WEQ BPS subcommittee, provided the update. The subcommittee continues to work on developing a long-term solution. The subcommittee narrowed down the options to two: 1) [hybrid](#) and 2) [flowgate allocation](#). A sizeable number of participants have been involved in the standards development process. The subcommittee will continue to work on narrowing the decisions down to one final solution.

UPDATE ON DSM-EE EFFORTS:

Wholesale Demand Response: At the December 1 DSM-EE subcommittee meeting the subcommittee voted out the phase 2 recommendation. It went out for a formal comment period and the wholesale DR work group reviewed those comments and drafted late formal comments for the WEQ EC to consider. The WEQ EC will vote on the [recommendation](#) at the February 1 meeting.

Wholesale Energy Efficiency: At the December 1 DSM-EE subcommittee meeting the subcommittee voted out the recommendation. It went out for a formal comment period, which the wholesale EE work group will consider in mid-February. Once those comments are reviewed, a single topic WEQ EC meeting will be scheduled to vote on the [recommendation](#).

Retail Demand Response: At the December 1 DSM-EE subcommittee meeting the subcommittee voted out the phase 2 recommendation. It went out for a formal comment period and the retail DR work group reviewed those comments and drafted late formal comments for the REQ EC to consider. The REQ EC will vote on the recommendation at the February 1 meeting.

Retail Energy Efficiency: The retail energy efficiency work group continues to draft its recommendation. They continue to draft language for the model business practices, including sections on baseline estimates for measurement burnout vs. early retirement, energy efficiency programs, general evaluation plan requirements and select gross savings approaches.

UPDATE ON SMART GRID ACTIVITIES: Mr. Booe, NAESB counsel, provided an update on the ongoing Smart Grid activities. On October 14 the subcommittee voted out the phase 2 efforts for PAP03, PAP04 and PAP09. The formal comment period ended in mid-November and the subcommittee reviewed the comments in order to prepare late formal comments for the WEQ and REQ EC to consider. The ECs are scheduled to vote on the recommendation at the February 1 and 2 meetings. The NIST SGIP governing board is reviewing the PAP10 work to include in their recommendation to the FERC.

The Energy Service Provider task force continues to meet and draft its recommendation. This work is an effort to standardize and improve upon the Open ADE specifications that were reviewed late last year. This work has a second quarter completion date.

The Data Privacy task force has begun to meet to create model business practices for data privacy.

UPDATE ON THE WEQ OASIS EFFORTS: JT Wood, co-chair of the OASIS subcommittee, provided the update. OASIS has focused on [NITS](#) on OASIS; in particular, it has reviewed the informal comments submitted. The WEQ-001 and WEQ-003 standards are complete. The subcommittee is in the process of drafting the technical aspects of NITS for WEQ-002 and WEQ-013, and should be done shortly.

The [SAMTS](#) task force reviewed the provisionally denied work paper that was included in the WEQ EC scope document. This work was presented to the OASIS subcommittee. The subcommittee also began to draft the WEQ-001 standards and developed a parking lot of items for the technical teams to review. Both NITS and SAMTS should be complete in the first quarter.



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2011 ANNUAL PLANS: The 2011 Annual Plans for the [WEQ](#), [WGQ](#) and [Retail](#) quadrants were reviewed.
